Building Permit Fees for project with total values of \$500,001 to \$1,000,000 are \$3,233.75 for the first \$500,000 plus \$4.75 for each additional \$1,000 or fraction thereof up to and including \$1,000,000. Building Permit Fees for projects with total values of \$1,000,001 or more are \$5,608.75 for the first \$1,000,000 plus \$3.15 for each additional \$1,000 or fraction thereof.
