

RESOLUTION NO. R16-33

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE FINDINGS OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT AND DETERMINING THAT AN ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENT IS NOT NECESSARY FOR THE PHASE 4 WATER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City of Laurel, Montana ("City") has completed an assessment to identify potential environmental impacts of the Phase 4 Water System Improvements Project;

WHEREAS, the draft Environmental Assessment was made available for public comment and the findings were presented and reviewed at a public meeting;

WHEREAS, no substantive public comment was received;

WHEREAS, the City has determined that the Phase 4 Water System Improvements Project will not significantly affect the quality of the human environment and accordingly, the City has determined an Environmental Impact Statement is not necessary;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council as follows:


That the City of Laurel does hereby adopt the final Environmental Assessment for the Phase 4 Water System Improvements Project.


